INSTRUCTIONS "TUMBLING ROCK FLUME"



As with all Family Action Agents teaching videos, learning and fun are our top priorities! You have just purchased an excellent TOOL to help your kids learn from the Word of God!

It is important to review the video a few times to be aware of how it is presented and to be comfortable in its presentation. In other words, you want to have a sense of command and excitement that beams out of you while this experience is happening! Remember, a tool does not take the place of you as a leader! It is there to enhance the gifting of talents God has given to you in instructing your kids!

The best advice is to think of yourself as a TV game show host! You will not just be playing a video and sitting back waiting for your kids to respond, but will be right there with them in the moment and excitement that transpires.

TUMBLING ROCK FLUME is a water ride! When a team wins a contest, they will be able to go down the BIG SPLASH. And when they hit bottom, THEY WILL GET WET! Have already prepared spray bottles filled with water (Use spray bottles from a discount store instead of squirt guns that do not allow for the desired effect in this game.) hidden in an easily accessible location behind the student's seating area. Secretly tell leadership before the game starts that at the end of the game as soon as the ride hits the water in the video, they should begin going down the aisles squirting the kids. TRY NOT TO SQUIRT STUDENTS IN THE FACE!

Introduce this video game to your students by telling them you are all going to KIDS ON THE ROCK FAMILY CARNIVAL. One of the rides you will be going on is TUMBLING ROCK FLUME - it's a water ride. When a team wins a contest, they will be able to go down the BIG SPLASH. And when they hit bottom, THEY WILL GET WET! Start by making 2 teams (example girls vs. boys) seated in separate sections. Then, go over the instructions on how to play the game. Let the kids know that you will read a Bible question a couple of times. During a 10 second countdown YOU will RUN back and forth picking students from the 2 teams to give an answer. Once they give an answer, they must stand up. The video will then show the correct answer. Whoever got it correct, will remain standing. If they got it wrong, they must sit down. (Assign a leader (adult) to count how many students are STANDING UP on EACH team and write it down. IF YOU HAVE A LARGE AUDIENCE OF STUDENTS, IT IS WISE TO HAVE EACH TEAM COUNTED BY A DIFFERENT LEADERSHIP PERSON. It is suggested to assign each team 1000 points for each correct answer. Remember, no one is to know how many points each side has until the end of the game.

At the end of the game, "Bob Barker" (on video) will begin to explain what's coming up in the BIG SPLASH. At this time, you will quickly tell the kids how many points each team has. Then, tell the winning team to stay seated, and make sure their seat belts are on, while going down the BIG SPLASH.

AT THIS POINT AT LEAST 2 LEADERSHIP SHOULD BE STANDING BEHIND THE STUDENTS WITH SPRAY BOTTLES, ONE ON EACH SIDE OF WHERE THE STUDENTS ARE SEATED. HOLDING BOTTLES AT THEIR SIDES SO AS NOT TO LET STUDENTS KNOW WHAT'S GOING ON.

As soon as the ride hits the water, they should begin going down the aisles squirting the kids. TRY NOT TO SQUIRT STUDENTS IN THE FACE!

This ride comes in 4 different episodes with different questions in each. Once kids know that by winning they get wet, they will want to play this video game over and over!

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
